### Cursillo

Over the course of a three-day retreat participants listen to fifteen different spiritual talks about the Christian life. The talks relate to real-life experiences, which become the basis for small-group discussions.

After a Cursillo event, participants are encouraged to take what they've learned that weekend and apply it to their daily lives. Participants are then invited to group reunions and larger gatherings called *Ultreya* ("to go further") and are frequently held here at St. Rita.
